Essential Resources

- Clay/plasticine /blu tac
- A fired pot
- Dried out clay
- *Lord teach us to pray* (book)
- Jeremiah 18:1-6

Gather/Symbolic Action

One child takes a piece of clay/blu tac and passes it on.

All children pass it around, playing/reshaping it.

Put clay/blu tac next to fired pot.

Leader: In your hands the clay/blu tac is constantly being changed and touched by other people. The change may be slight. Do we like the changes? Was it the same as when it began?

(Draw attention to the fired pot. We cannot change it. It must remain the same.)

Word

Leader: Read Jeremiah 18: 1-6 (slowly, giving time to reflect)

God is always there. Does he want you to remain the same?

Who has shaped you in your life? A teacher, friend, brother?

Read: *Lord teach us to pray* (p 24)

(Show a dried out piece of clay.) This has dried out and will crumble. We need the Holy Spirit to pour into our lives so we can be moulded by Christ.

Sing: (with actions) Spirit of the living God (raise arms with upturned hands)

Reflecting and Praying

Lord God, you are our Father:

You the potter, and we the clay.

Your own hands have shaped us and modelled us.

Re-form us now so that we may more closely resemble

The image and likeness of Jesus, your Son.

Lead us to live in such a way today

That others may recognise that we are made by your hands.
